

**TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

**Article 12 - Instructional Materials**

12-1 In order to provide the best possible educational program in each school, the District ~~will endeavor-shall~~to provide sufficient instructional materials and equipment to ensure that each pupil and teacher will have access to them.

12-1-1 Prior to final preparation of budgets for materials and supplies, the CSC, in consultation with ~~the~~ teachers affected, will determine an equitable distribution of resources in the proposed school budget for instructional materials that are not otherwise provided by the District. The final ~~building~~-budgets will reflect the priorities established by the CSC.

12-1-2 Each school will ~~be allocated a revolving fund through their~~ budget ~~accounts to use for the purpose of~~ instructional materials that are necessary for the academic program at the school. ~~not otherwise readily obtainable by teachers~~.

12-2 The Association and the District support equal educational opportunity for all children in the Denver Public Schools. It is their mutual aim, through the careful selection of multi-ethnic instructional materials, to help students develop a sense of individual worth and respect for the worth of others, regardless of their ethnic or cultural backgrounds.
