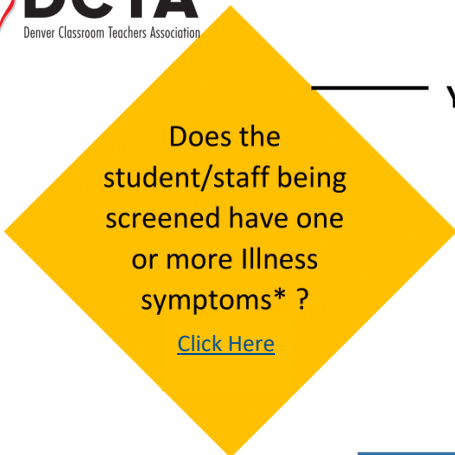




COVID-19 Screening and COVID-19 Testing Decision Tree

YES

Instruct the individual to stay at home or go home and ISOLATE and follow the next steps below

*Schedule a school-based health center in-person or telemedicine appointment by calling 303-602-8958

Next steps for isolation depend on testing



Return to Work/Activity Criteria:

- At least 10 days have passed since symptom onset or since the date of the test (if asymptomatic) AND
- 24 hrs fever free without using medicine

*Isolation is never less than 10 days.

Return to Work/Activity Criteria:

- 24 hrs fever free without using medicine

*No notes are needed to return to schools (verbal report is ok)

*No test result can end an individual's quarantine period earlier than 7 days.

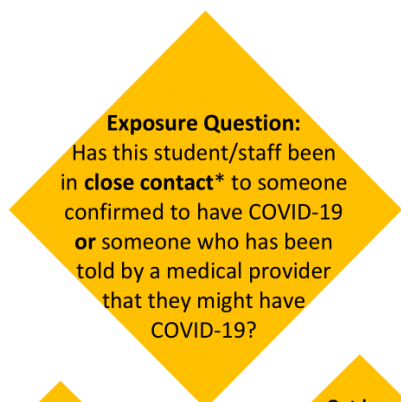

If NO, ask this exposure question

Return to Work/Activity Criteria for Vaccinated and Unvaccinated individuals:

- The initial symptoms resolved within 24 hours of symptom onset OR
- Person had only MINOR symptoms and symptoms resolved in 48 hours OR
- At least 10 days have passed since symptom onset AND 24 hrs fever free without using medicine

*Major: loss of smell, fever >100.4, cough, problems breathing
 *Minor: Sore throat, Runny nose or, congestion, Muscle or body aches, Headache, Fatigue, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea
 *Unchanged, usual symptoms of a known chronic condition should not prompt exclusion
 *Schedule a school-based health center in-person or telemedicine appointment by calling 303-602-8958



YES

If not exempt from quarantine, instruct the student/staff to go home and QUARANTINE for:

- 10 days if not exhibiting symptoms (no testing required) OR
- 7 days if not exhibiting symptoms with proof of a negative PCR or Molecular COVID-19 test result. The test cannot be given earlier than day 5 from the last exposure and they cannot be in close contact with high risk people.

EXEMPTION from Quarantine for classroom exposures:

- Fully vaccinated without symptoms (two weeks after last recommended vaccine dose) OR
- Previously positive in the past 90 without symptoms day OR
- Both parties were wearing a mask properly over the mouth and nose at the time of exposure and without symptoms

*CDC recommendation: Fully vaccinated people who have a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 should be tested 3-5 days after exposure, regardless of whether or not they have symptoms.

Outdoor exposures:
There will be no quarantines or contact tracing unless directed by the health department.

May attend work or activities

Return to Work/Activity Criteria:

- 10 days if not exhibiting symptoms (if no testing) OR
- 7 days if not exhibiting symptoms with proof of a negative PCR or Molecular COVID-19 test result. The test cannot be given earlier than day 5 from the last exposure and they cannot be in close contact with high risk people.

*Definition of close contact: Children who were within 3 feet (adults 6 feet) of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period. Fully vaccinated people who have a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 should be tested 3-5 days after exposure, regardless of whether or not they have symptoms. Outdoor exposure: There will be no quarantines or contact tracing unless directed by the health dept.
